## Purpose of Role:

The post holder will be a member of the College Digital Learning team, working closely with course teams and other academic and professional staff to create effective and engaging pedagogic experiences for our students. This will require expertise in online and blended pedagogies and the planning and production of earning media and curricula activities to enhance digital teaching and learning across the curriculum.

The post holder will have experience of developing Digital Learning and blended materials in an educational setting. The post-holder will have project, people management and excellent communication skills to ensure that projects are delivered on-time and on-budget.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Working with course teams and other relevant staff, taking editorial and budgetary responsibility for the codesign, development and implementation of blended and/or Digital Learning responding to agreed frameworks.
- To lead and work alongside academic, technical and administrative staff in the design, development and implementation of effective online, blended learning and related content.
- Working with Associate Dean Teaching and Learning / Head of Digital Learning to respond to college and university academic and digital strategies.
- To identify requirements for, and design and deliver Digital Learning staff development.
- To work with colleagues throughout the College and University to plan and define appropriate services and Digital Learning environments to ensure the effective and sustainable implementation of Digital Learning.
- Actively engage with and develop the university wide network of Digital Learning.
- To ensure that Digital Learning activities and practice comply with University and other relevant regulations and standards.
- Contribute to the design, and lead on, the implementation of College/University facing research and evaluation of Digital Learning to inform our direction and activities.
- To establish and manage schedule and budget and ensure project goals are met.
- To define and implement project communication protocols (including estimates, project plans and status, updates, risks and issues).
- To test and evaluate learning materials and pedagogical approaches to ensure relevant quality standards are met.
- To ensure compliance with legislation and best practice concerning accessibility and usability in Digital Learning.
- Undertake scholarly activity (research, knowledge exchange or teaching) related to Digital Learning.
- To manage staff, projects and budgets as may be appropriate.
- To attend and contribute to meetings and events as required.
- To perform such duties consistent with your role as may from time to time be assigned to you anywhere within the University.
- To undertake health and safety duties and responsibilities appropriate to the role.

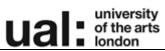
