Purpose of Role:

The post holder will be a member of the College Digital Learning team, working with course teams to support and develop the use of the Digital Learning platforms across the college to enhance learning and teaching.

The role will involve working with a range of academic and professional staff to develop high quality learning resources and designs. The post holder will also create online guidance and training material and develop and facilitate staff development sessions.

The post holder will have experience of developing Digital Learning in an educational setting; must have strong communication skills and the ability to work across multiple projects effectively, as well as prioritising their own time.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Offer expert Digital Learning advice and support to course teams and related key areas such as Academic Support, Library, Disability and Technical teams.
- To work alongside academic, technical and administrative staff to design, develop and implement effective online, blended learning and related content.
- Act as mentor or change agent for staff who wish to introduce technology into their teaching practice codeveloping pedagogic approaches in response to agreed frameworks.
- Be an active member of the university wide network of Digital Learning
- Work with colleagues to develop and deliver Digital Learning training and staff development
- Contribute to the design and implementation of college/university facing research and evaluation of Digital Learning to inform our direction and activities.
- Contribute to the upgrade, testing and development of the core Digital Learning platforms.
- Assist the embedding of practice and support around the introduction of Digital Learning platforms
- · Advise on the development direction and design of our current Digital Learning platforms
- Assist in gathering key metrics and qualitative data relating to our Digital Learning services and platforms
- Undertake scholarly activity (research, knowledge exchange or teaching) related to Digital Learning
- To ensure compliance with legislation concerning accessibility and usability in Digital Learning
- To manage staff, projects and budgets as may be appropriate
